



Clinic Fee Schedule

Haley Brooke base her service rates on her qualifications, knowledge and experience.

Fees

Our Treatment Fees are outlined within the information sheets provided on the website

* Subject to discounts on offer from time to time.

Deposits

A non-refundable deposit is required to secure your booking. This allows the nurse to ensure there is adequate time and supplies, in order for your appointment to run smoothly. Your deposit is deducted from your total treatment fee at the end of the appointment.

GST

Haley Brooke Industries is registered for Goods and Services Tax. This is a 10% charge allocated to the government that will be in addition to your service charges.

For example: If your total appointment charge was \$58.00, the GST charge would be \$5.80.

Your overall service charge would be \$63.80

Kilometre Charges for Mobile Services

To cover the motor vehicle and fuel costs associated with your private in-home treatments, a per-kilometer charge is calculated. This minor charge is based on your distance measured in kilometers (KM's) from the post office in Central Bundaberg or the post office in Childers.

The rate of \$1.50 will be charged per kilometer.

For example: It was 18km round trip from the central Bundaberg post office to your house and back again. You would be charged \$27.00.

Methods of Payment

Cash

We accept cash payments. This method of payment is great if you prefer cash and does not include a card surcharge, reducing your overall total. However, our staff do not carry change with them so **exact cash** payment is required.

*An estimated service quote can be provided prior to appointment, to determine potential cash amount.

Eftpos

We offer a Square-pos terminal for EFTPOS payments. This payment method accepts VISA, Mastercard and most other cards. This payment method will incur an additional card charge of 2.0%.

For example: If your overall service fee was \$38.00, your payment would be \$38.00 + 0.76 (2.0%), total of \$38.76.

Bank Transfer

We understand you may prefer to pay for your private nursing service via the use of direct bank transfer. The direct bank transfer payment will be required at the end of each visit. Your nurse will provide the details for transfer and a confirmation receipt of payment sent to your nurse is required.
